"...we have found no evidence that the Saudi government as an institution or senior Saudi officials individually funded the organization."

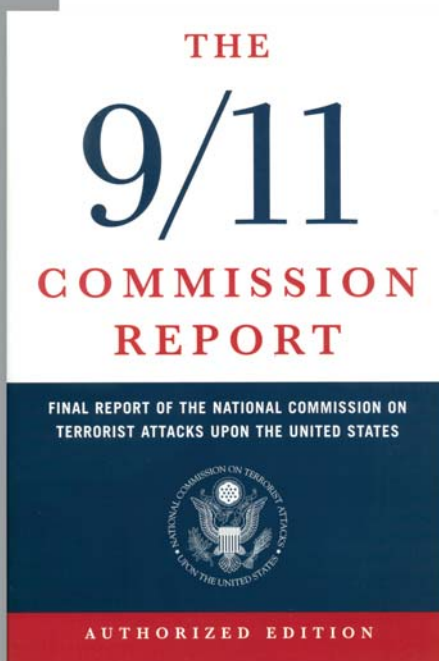
On allegations of clandestine flights and political favors...

"The CIA learned in the spring of 1998 that the Saudi government had quietly disrupted Bin Ladin cells in its country that were planning to attack U.S. forces.... They had arrested scores of individuals with no publicity."
